To all Berryhill Growers,

Berryhill Foods does not require growers to test their fruit for pesticide residues. Berryhill takes responsibility to ensure that the fruit received is sampled for pesticide residue testing. We carefully review pesticide records from each grower and compare them with pesticide testing results to ensure that fruit meets the maximum residue limits (MRL) of the destination markets, which include Canada, the USA, Korea and Japan. Berryhill MRL lists are available to growers upon request.

Growers are aware of the possibility that their fruit may be exported to one or more countries. Growers have the responsibility for ensuring their pesticide applications meet all federal and provincial regulations. In addition, growers must follow the guidance provided by Berryhill Foods regarding restrictions in destination markets. If a grower feels it is necessary to use one of the products on the restricted list provided by Berryhill Foods, the grower must contact Berryhill prior to use. Berryhill will then evaluate the situation, test the product, and/or divert the product to the appropriate market.

Please keep a copy in your **CanadaGAP** manual for your records.

Note: This document covers all pre-harvest, harvest, and post-harvest chemical applications from March 31, 2025 to March 31, 2026.
